New Student Enrollment Priorities for 2018-19 School Year

The Victoria School District has implemented new enrollment priorities for registering your child for the 2018-19 school year. These new parameters were put in place to prevent over-crowding in some district schools where neighbourhood children can end up being denied access to their catchment school. This is not the case at Glanford and we expect to have room for all of our Grade 6 students wishing to attend GMS in the fall. For students currently in grades 6 and 7 at GMS, all of these students are automatically part of our numbers for September 2018. Our current grade 8 students will receive a letter from the school district in January, informing families of the expected high school for your child (determined by address). For students in grade 8 wishing to attend a high school other than the one they are expected to attend, they will be required to submit a transfer application between February 15th - 23rd. Please visit the district website for details and don't miss this Transfer Application Process to secure your spot at your chosen high school if you don't currently reside in that school's catchment.


