We are at the time of year where we begin planning for the 2025-2026 school year. Our grade 8 students have selected their courses for secondary and we have registered our incoming grade 6s. We will soon begin our class placement process. All classes are developed to meet the mandated class size and composition guidelines. As we build classes we consider learning strengths and needs, social/emotional factors, inclusive learning balance, and productive peer pairings. Staff put significant time and consideration into the process. Students will have the opportunity to share 4 positive learning partner names they would possibly like to be placed with.
