We are at the time of year where we begin planning for the 2025-2026 school year. Our grade 8 students have selected their courses for secondary and we have registered our incoming grade 6s. MAY IS MENTAL HEALTH MONTH – we have a lot going on – check out the calendar. More is going to be added!

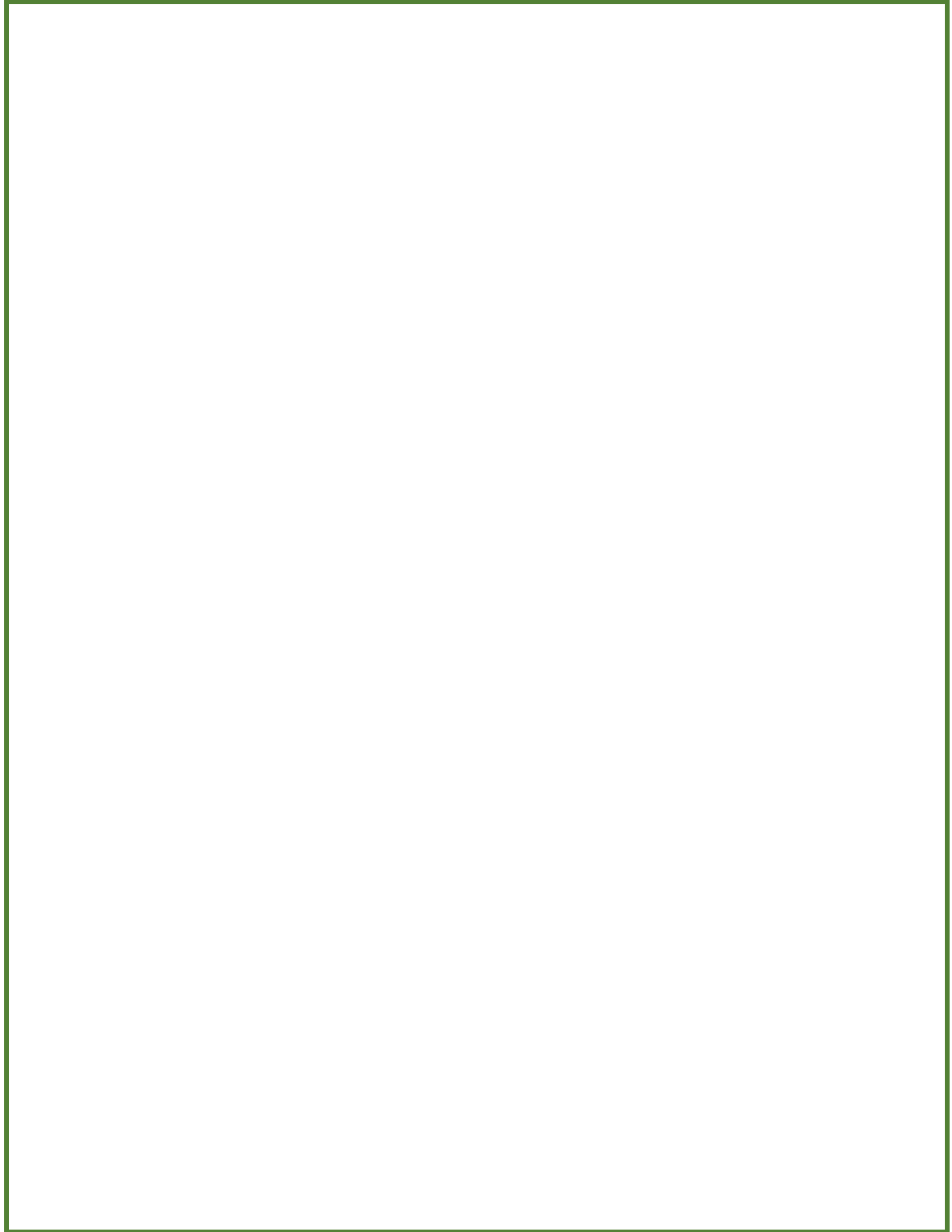

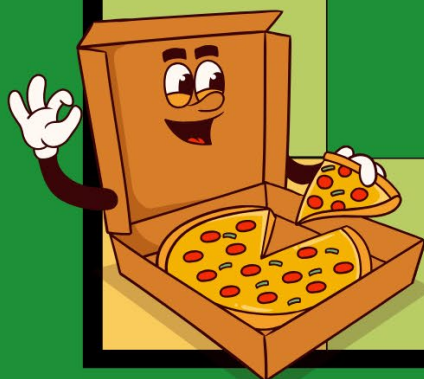
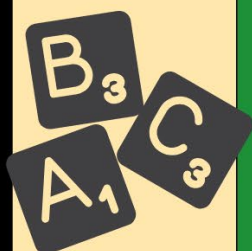
