Grade 6 students may be eligible for additional vaccines if they are not up to date. A letter with instructions on providing consent for immunizations will be sent home to students shortly. Creating Connections

Each Glanford student will complete one square of our patchwork quilt. Your square will represent your family's culture. Like a patchwork quilt, a family and a community are made of diverse pieces that come together in a special way. You may use pencils, felts, material, pictures, words or symbols to decorate your patch, as long as it fits on the square. Ask your family to help. Consider the following questions about your culture when thinking about what to include and share:

What is something you celebrate together as a family? What is something your family enjoys doing together? What is something that represents you, your family, or your ancestors?

World Map Activity - Where are we from?

We want to know where our GMS community is from. Canada, Victoria and GMS are culturally diverse communities! Families have immigrated to Canada for centuries and Indigenous people have lived on this land for thousands of years.

Is your family from an Indigenous nation, or nations? Did your parents, grandparents or great-grandparents move to Canada from another part of the world, or maybe you moved to Canada with your family? Use the map on the back of this page to locate the places in the world your ancestors are from. With your class, you will be given a sticker to mark where your ancestors are from on our school map by the office.
