### What is Law Day?

Law Day is an annual event when the courthouse is opened to members of the public on a Saturday to allow them to learn about the functions of the justice system. You can learn about the roles played by lawyers, judges, and courthouse staff in ensuring a fair and independent justice system; and about legal and other justice-related services available in Victoria and surrounding areas.

Law Day in Victoria is organized by volunteers in the local legal community with generous support from the Victoria Bar Association.
