We are looking forward to the annual GMS Year-End Picnic at Beaver Lake on **Friday, June 19th**. This is always a fun day and a great opportunity to celebrate the year as a whole school community. The day includes a walk or cycle to the lake, lawn games, craft tables, food, and friends. In honour of National Indigenous Peoples Day on June 21st, we will bring our drums and invite staff and students to drum before lunch.

Staff and students will walk or cycle to and from Beaver Lake Park. We will leave the school at approximately 9 am and arrive at Beaver Lake at approximately 10 am. At the end of the day, we will clean up, leave Beaver Lake at approximately 1:30 pm, and return to GMS at approximately 2:30 pm.

The Central Saanich Lions will be serving up freshly barbecued hot dogs and veggie dogs along with a bag of chips and a cold drink. We are thankful to the GMS PAC for contributing to this lunch! Please supplement your child's lunch as needed and send them prepared with a hat, sunscreen, and water. Comfortable walking shoes are important. Students will not be swimming.

In the spirit of community and organization, all students walk back to the school together. Students will not be dismissed along the route.

The cost of lunch is subsidized through hot lunch sales and PAC fundraising. We ask that families contribute \$2.00 each towards lunch.
